In our sorrows we hit on the idea to start up a Golf Society of our own and Stan Fenner then said to John "you can be Treasurer" - to me he said "you can be Secretary" to Alan he said "you can be a member and I'll be Captain" - or words to that effect. We decide there and then to call it The Wesley Golf Society due to our association with the Methodist Church.
